Background and Rationale: The College solicited proposals from companies for a fully interactive video room to assist EMT training by creating environments that students will have to master. The characteristics of the desired system were listed, and a library of existing environments was also requested. The College received only one proposal. Echo Healthcare of Sarasota Florida provided a comprehensive solution including all hardware & software required, a library of prerecorded scenarios, complete installation & training, and a 1 year warranty package for \$118,490.00. References were checked prior to this recommendation. The EMT Program received a Texas Reskilling & Upskilling for Education (TRUE) Grant to assist Colleges and their students needing new or additional skills training in order to reenter the workforce. This purchase will use those grant funds plus money transferred from the Plant Fund.
