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COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This course is open to students interested in musical theater production.. All students will take an active part in all aspects of the production. Each trimester will culminate in a live production put on for the community.

COURSE GOALS:

Students will:

- learn about the multiple disciplines involved in a musical production including vocal and instrumental music
- learn about acting
- learn set design and lighting, costuming, and sound design.
- Apply artistic elements and technical skills to create, present, and/or perform works of musical theater for an audience.
- Improve confidence when performing in a group for an audience.
- Improve kinesthetic, vocal, interpretive, and enunciation skills.

ASSESSMENT STRATEGIES:

Daily in-class participation; participation in after school rehearsals, set-building, etc; quizzes; participation in final production.
