The work at both Walsh and Morningstar is proceeding at a rapidly increasing rate. In fact, just two weeks ago Walsh opened the development for purchase of lots. Thus far, Morningstar is roughly on track with the anticipated enrollment projected in the most recent demographic estimates. While Walsh is selling lots for construction of homes, I anticipate little to no occupancy until the first quarter of 2018.

At this writing, it has been reported by a representative of Walsh that fifty-six lots have been sold with twenty-five others that should be finalized in the next several days. Administration extends congratulation on the Walsh Development's grand opening. We look forward to a long and fruitful relationship with the master planned communities.
