We recognize that housing is a critical resource for all employees and that employees who are new to the school district may face challenges in securing adequate housing. The district is committed to expanding housing opportunities for staff over time, but is faced with the reality of limited available units at the inception of this program. Therefore, priorities for district housing are established based on a comprehensive evaluation of the impact of positions on both overall staff and students. The first phase of the program will serve as a recruitment tool for hard to fill positions. Leases will be limited to three, one-year lease terms. We are working to develop additional housing..

Applicants will be scored initially on the following: (1) length of time the position was posted; (2) priority tool score; (3) start date; and (4) total members in household. Applicants with the highest score will have priority for applying for District housing. Applicants will be notified of their priority status and given further instructions.
