Board members expressed their appreciation for the indepth presentation.


President Drake reminded all present that an open discussions with audience members is not aloud.





### Band Lesson Initiative with Cottonwood Oak Creek School District

Director Josh Stallworth presented Band Lesson Initiative with Cottonwood Oak Creek School District. Superintendent Herne commended Director Stallworth enthusiasm. Superintendent Herne informed the board regarding the overwhelming support Cottonwood Oak Creek School District has for this new initiative.

Board member questions were answered during the presentation.

Board Member Lozano stated that Director Stallworth is not presenting a new program but sharing an opportunity for us to do better for our students. This will improve the program that we currently have, he likes that. This initiative is not an expense but, an investment.

### MUHS Safety Plan Mutual Link

Athletic Director Yancey DeVore presented the current security plan and communication systems; Raptor and Mutualink. Upcoming training will be October 23, 2024. Questions by board members were answered as the presentation took place. Principal Beery commented, we are using systems that other schools are using in the county for safety and security. It was stressed that all safety proudures should not be made public due to the complex nature of school campus security.

### Weighted G.P.A.

Principal Beery presented information regarding Weighted G.P.A. Questions by the board were answered as the presentation took place.

Board Member Babcock would like to have administration look at adding Duel Enrollment classes to the Weighted G.P.A. calculations. Superintendent Herne asked the board for clarification, the board is asking for AP and Duel Enrollment classes to be weighted the same. Superintendent Herne states that this request will be given back to the Leadership Team for research. Once research is completed, a proposed model will be presented.

### **Band Lesson Initiative Stipend**

Superintendent Herne reviewed the Band Lesson Initiative Stipend. Current board approved stipend is \$35.00 per instructional hour. This proposal will be capped at 12 hours per week.

Board Member Babcock asked if there was a reason why Cottonwood Oak Creek School District is not contributing to this initiative.

Superintendent Herne states that would be the direction we would like to pursue in the future.
