SUMMARY:

This item requests approval of the Pathway Communications quote for the projector upgrade at Harpool Middle School. The project cost totals \$155,604.00.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The projectors that are currently at Harpool Middle School are the ones that were original to the campus when it opened in 2008. The projectors that will be installed are digital instead of the analog projectors that are currently in place. This project will replace projectors in 56 rooms and 3 Fine Arts rooms. This project was presented to the Lantana Foundation.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES:

- Pathways Communications will be utilized for this purchase thru the TIPS Cooperative.
- This purchase is being brought for approval in accordance with the District's CH Local Policy.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:

The Lantana Foundation has accepted and granted the funding for these projectors, including the installation and the cabling.

BENEFIT OF ACTION:

The projectors can be installed and ready for student use.
