STUDENT CONDUCT: ALCOHOL AND DRUG USE

**FNCF** (LOCAL)

**DEFINITIONS** "Use" means a student has voluntarily introduced into his or her body by any means

a prohibited substance recently enough that it is detectable by the student's

physical appearance, actions, breath, or speech.

"Under the influence" means not having the normal use of mental or physical

faculties; however, the student need not be legally intoxicated.

In addition to the statutory ban on the possession, use, or transmittal of controlled **PROHIBITIONS** 

substances, dangerous drugs, and alcohol [see FNCF(LEGAL)], the District

prohibits:

The possession, use, or transmittal of paraphernalia related to any prohibited

substance.

The possession, transmittal, sale, or attempted sale of what is represented to be

any prohibited substance.

PRESCRIPTION DRUGS

A student who uses a drug authorized by a licensed physician through a prescription specifically for the student's use shall not be considered to have

violated this policy.

**VIOLATIONS** Students who violate this policy shall be subject to disciplinary action and may be

required to complete an appropriate rehabilitation program. [See FO series]

**SEARCHES** Care and lockers may be searched for alcohol and drugs in accordance with Board

policy. [See FNF(LEGAL) and (LOCAL)]
