# Consider Approval of Contracts Exceeding \$50,000 August 19, 2024

## Background:

In Spring 2024 the UCISD Curriculum and Instruction Department completed a comprehensive needs assessment to assist in creating the 2024-2025 District Improvement Plan. As the State releases additional accountability information the division continuously updates the goals, objectives, and actions listed in the plan. Based on the data, the attached programs, initiatives, and professional development opportunities are being brought before the Board for those programs exceeding the \$50,000 expenditure level.

As part of the budget development, the Business, Human Resources and Technology departments have reviewed their needs as well and will be participating with several cooperatives with the Education Service Center, Region 20.

#### Process:

Each program area supervisor conducts a needs assessment in the Spring to evaluate program implementation of the current year. As the State releases new information this information is reviewed and used to update the District Improvement Plan and the District Targeted Improvement Plan. Goals, Objectives, Strategies, and Interventions are developed to address the needs outlined in the DIP.

The C&I Department researched several products, programs and methodologies to address the identified needs in math, reading, writing, new teacher support, credit recovery, and accelerated instructions. Data Analysis of all programs were conducted by Principals, Instructional Coaches, and Curriculum and Instruction Staff.

The research, data analysis, and program evaluations resulted in the recommendation to purchase the presented programs.

## Fiscal Impact:

The purchase of the recommended necessary expenditures will be funded through federal, state, and local funds.

#### Recommendation:

It is recommended that the Board approve the expenditures from categorical/local funds to support the described programs, products, initiatives, and professional development intended to improve teacher quality, instructional practices, and student performance as presented.
