Denton Independent School District Houston Elementary Playground Replacement Project Purchase

SUMMARY:

This item requests approval of the quotes from WeBuildFun in the amount of \$279,927.82 for the playground replacement projects at Houston Elementary.

BOARD GOAL:

Growth & Management - Demonstrate effective and efficient management of district resources

PREVIOUS BOARD ACTION:

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

This project was initiated by the Board of Trustees due to the age and condition of the playground equipment at many of the District's Elementary Schools.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES:

Included in this purchase and installation are Phase I and Phase II of the playground equipment for Houston Elementary. Due to the proximity of the two structures, it was determined that a single installation of the fall surface would be the most efficient and cost-effective. The placement of both structures on the single fall surface necessitated a need for the redesign of Phase I.

This playground equipment and installation will be purchased through a Texas Local Governmental Purchasing Cooperative BuyBoard contract. This purchase is being brought for approval in accordance with the District's CH (local) policy.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:

The cost will be borne through the major maintenance assigned fund balance in the amount of \$279,927.82.

BENEFIT OF ACTION:

The approval of this purchase will allow the District to move forward with the playground replacement project.

SUPERINTENDENT'S RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the quote from WeBuildFun in the amount of \$279,927.82 for the playground replacement project at Houston Elementary be approved.
