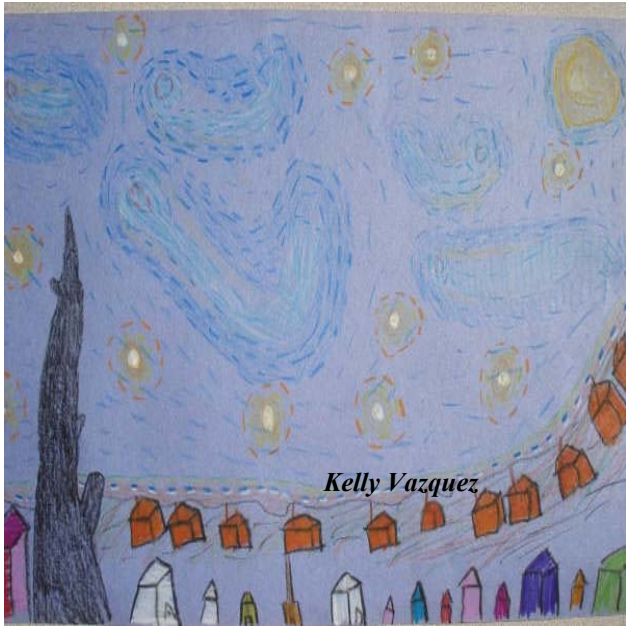
*Close your eyes and have a very nice sleep

They leave a path that you can follow.*

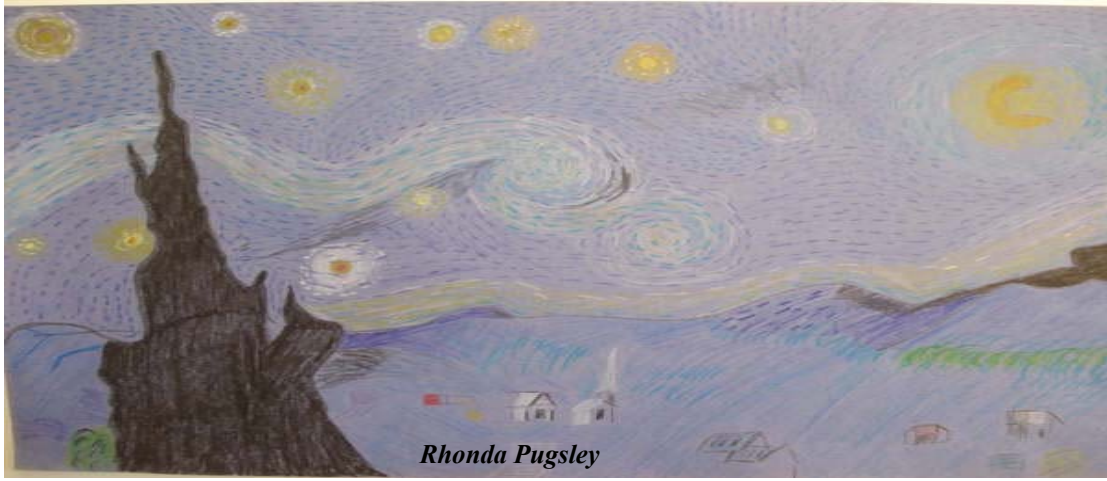




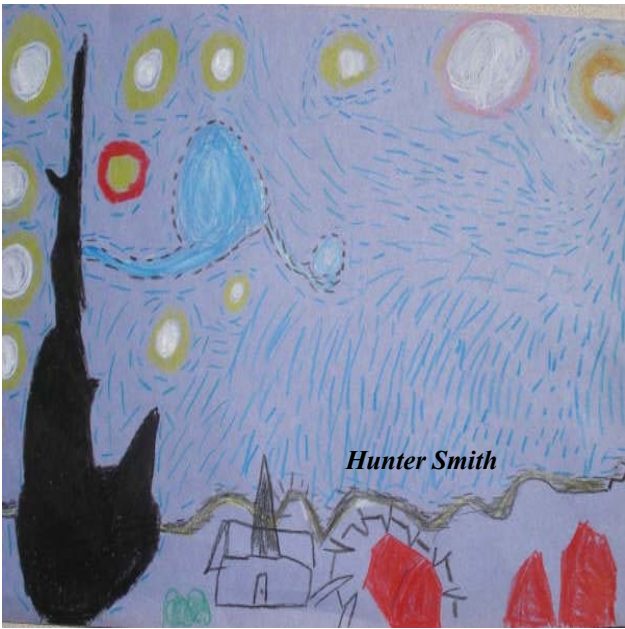
