1. Opening and Call to Order Board Chair

Chair Gregg welcomed everyone and called the work session to order at 8:00 a.m.

1.1. Pledge of Allegiance

The group stood and recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

1.2. Meeting Audio Recorded

Chair Gregg stated that this meeting is being audio/video recorded.

2. Integrated Pest Management (IPM) Report Brian Norris

Bryan Franklin explained that the Integrated Pest Management (IPM) program dictates the Pendleton School District procedures for managing pests, including the chemicals used and application. The IPM is a common-sense strategy that focuses on long-term solutions to pest problems based on a better understanding of pest biology and with minimum impact on human health and the environment. Brian Norris and Bryan Franklin were available for questions.

3. CTE/Schools to Career Curt Thompson, Patti Hyatt

Curt Thompson, Assistant Principal at PHS, shared a slideshow with the different sections of the Career Technical Education offered at Pendleton High School. It included the revamping of the Carl Perkins Funding on a four-year rotation, Media/Digital Arts, Engineering and Robotics, FFA, Agriculture Science, Hospitality and Tourism, and Work Based Learning Experiences. Abbey Prevot, an Art Teacher, and Bailey Sitts, an Aerospace and Engineering Teacher at PHS, shared what they learned at the Creative Conference they attended for professional development and how they will apply their knowledge in their classrooms.

Patti Hyatt, School to Careers Coordinator, shared the end-of-year report for 2023-24 and the year-to-date report for 2024-25. She shared how she is working with Eric Davis and Wes Armstrong. Together, they are revamping how they connect with students, present guest speakers, and change the focus from how many businesses come in and talk to how many students we can push out to the public/take students to the businesses and see firsthand the

careers they are interested in. 213 students are signed up for job shadows. The Career Connect Conference is held regionally at the Pendleton Convention Center on March 13, 2025, for over 500 students and 48 employers.

5. **TAG Program** *Julie Smith*

At the request of the board, Julie Smith, Director of Special Programs, gave an update to the Pendleton School District TAG Program, which included the new template provided by the state, the parent brochure, and the gifted profiles poster.
