

## **Elementary Principal's Report - February 2026**

### **Community Involvement and Awareness**

- The 5 Essentials survey opens on February 3rd for all Ridgeview families, staff, and students (4th and 5th only). This survey is part of our overall summative designation. We will begin getting more information out soon to encourage our stakeholders to complete this survey. The survey window closes on March 13th.
- The STANGS Royal Princess Ball dance was last Sunday 2/15 at 2:00 PM. Stangs arranged for corsages, pictures, and a great dance. Thank you to the dedicated parents of STANGS and those who attended the event.

### **Curriculum & Program Development/Staff Collaboration**

- The administration team will attend the Illinois State University career fair on 2/19. This event is a great opportunity to find prospective talent and also get word out about our outstanding school.
- Teachers met with myself and Mrs. Jamison regarding ELA curriculum on Tuesday 2/10. Mrs. Jamison shared information about recent implementation surveys as well as support through video lessons and assessment resources.
- Staff engaged in collaboration on Friday, 2/6 during the SIP day. They focused on our shared intervention time and other topics of interest, including special education, departmentalization, transitions, etc. They also received training on AI usage in schools and assisted with the evaluation of SEL and math curriculum.
