The Johnson County Children's Advocacy Center would like to offer a Prevention Education Program offered created by The Monique Burr Foundation Home.

The program is comprehensive, evidence based, and evidence informed. They offer two programs' Children Safety Matters which is for lower grades such as K-5 all grade levels are built upon each other meaning we are not going to talk to a Kindergarten student about the same things we would talk to a second-grade student about. The Child Safety Matters covers topics such as general safety, the four types of child abuse, Bullying /cyberbullying, digital safety and citizenship. The other program they offer is Teen Safety Matters which covers 6-12. This program helps the school get credit for Senate Bill 9 requirements. The Teen Safety program covers topic like Digital Safety, cyberbullying/ bullying, sexting, exploitation, the four types of child abuse, relationship abuse, sexual assault and exploitation / sex trafficking.

Senate Bill 9 (SB 9) of the 87th Texas Legislative Session requires school districts to offer curriculum to students in the prevention of child abuse (elementary & secondary), family violence (elementary & secondary), dating violence (secondary), and sex trafficking (secondary).
