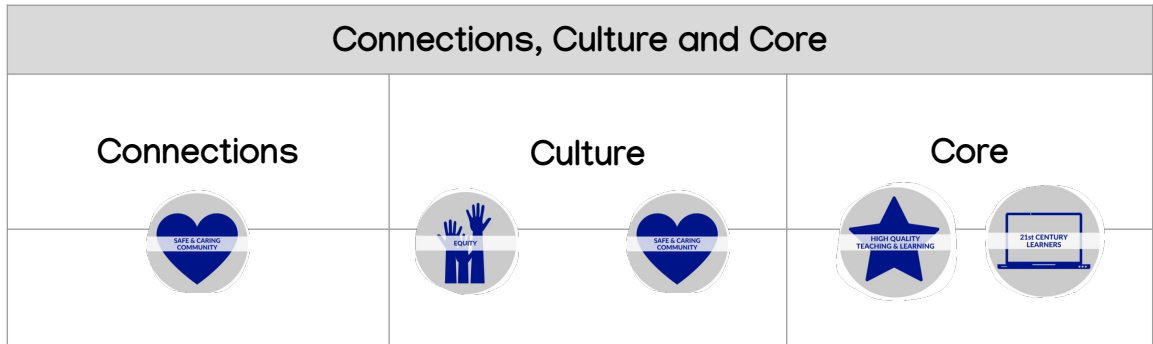

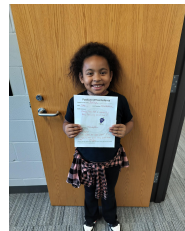
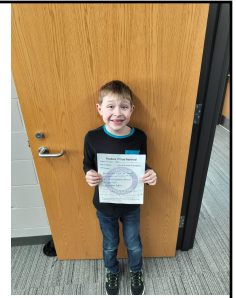

Good Table Manners: Using good table manners, cleaning up after themselves, and keeping the noise level down while eating.

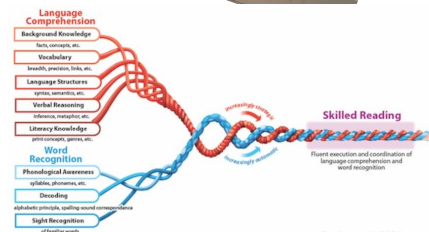
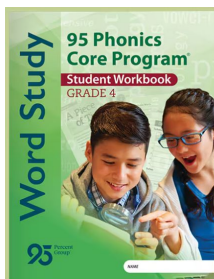
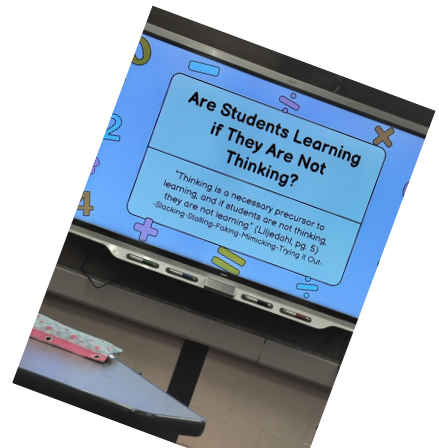
Following Directions: Listening to and following instructions from teachers and staff.
