Approval of the 2013-14 Middle School Re-zoning Plan

Tuesday - June 12, 2012

SUMMARY:

This item requests approval of the proposed middle school re-zoning plan for the 2013-14 school year. The purpose of re-zoning is three-fold. First, the opening of middle school #7 in August 2013 located adjacent to Olive Stephens Elementary School necessitates modification of existing boundaries. Secondly, to balance student populations at the remaining middle schools, except Navo Middle School. Finally, to align District middle school attendance lines with high school attendance lines – where & when possible.

BOARD GOAL:

- VI. Growth, Change & Fiscal Responsibility.... In pursuit of excellence, the district will:
 - Review and adjust policies and procedures as appropriate to address the challenges of rapid growth and changing demographic characteristics while maintaining and enhancing our strong sense of community.

PREVIOUS BOARD ACTION:

The Board was presented the proposed 2013-14 Middle School Re-zoning Plan on May 22, 2012. No action was taken.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The opening of Middle School 7 within the current Crownover attendance zone necessitates the modification of existing middle school boundaries to balance student populations and to align middle school boundaries with high school boundaries – where and when possible. All middle school attendance zones will be impacted except those at Navo Middle School. The functional capacity of our middle school campuses are 1,000 students. SIGNIFICANT ISSUES:

Harpool & Crownover Middle Schools will be over functional capacity by 2012-13 school year and Navo & Strickland Middle Schools will be over their functional capacity by 2014-15 school year (1,000 students = functional capacity). The proposed boundary change does not affect Navo Middle School. The District may need to place portables at Navo MS for the increased student enrollment prior to the construction of another middle school.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:

If the Proposed 2013-14 Middle School Attendance Plan is approved, the District will need to consider increased staffing for Middle School #7.

BENEFIT OF ACTION:

Passage of this action will help to alleviate overcrowding at our middle school campuses, assist to balance student populations and improve the alignment of our middle school boundaries with our high school attendance zones.

PROCEDURAL AND REPORTING IMPLICATIONS:

ALTERNATIVES:

Option #2:

Allow the Oaks of Montecito & Chaucer Estates to remain within the Harpool MS attendance boundary.

OTHER COMMENTS:

Transportation will be provided to those outside a two-mile radius of the campus. This is determined from property line to property line along a public roadway. District staff will continue to review this policy and ensure it fits within a holistic strategy.

SUPERINTENDENT'S RECOMMENDATION:

The Superintendent recommends the approval of the 2013-14 Middle School Re-zoning plan (Option 1). Those students that attend Harpool Middle School next year (2012-13 school year), and are to be rezoned to Crownover Middle School, will have the option to stay and finish along with any sibling if attending at the same time – provided they do the following:

- Students will need to go through the standard Transfer Request Process
 Middle School In-District Transfers: Please contact the desired middle school campus (i.e. Harpool MS must fill out form)
- 2) Parents and/or Guardians will need to provide transportation

Special Needs students school location will be on a case by case basis.

Once Harpool Middle School reaches 95% of functional capacity transfers will no longer be accepted. Exceptions are those students that will be in 8th grade along with any sibling attending the school at the same time. These students will be able to finish at Harpool MS.
