SUBJECT: Consider Approval of the Request to the Texas Education Agency for a Low Attendance Waiver

Background Information

- School districts may request a waiver to exclude specific instructional days from the ADA (average daily attendance) and FSP (Foundation School Program) funding calculations that have attendance at least 10 percentage points below the last school year’s overall average attendance.
- Due to inclement weather conditions, Duncanville ISD recorded a substantial average daily attendance decline on January 23 and 29, 2026.
- The ADA on January 23, 2026, was 73.38% and January 29, 2026, was 74.05%.
- The ADA for Duncanville ISD in the 2024-2025 school year was 91.78%.
- Due to Duncanville ISD’s average daily attendance on January 23 and 29, 2026, and exceeding the 10-percentage points difference from last year’s ADA, we are requesting approval to submit a waiver to the Texas Education Agency to exclude January 23 and 29, 2026 attendance from the attendance funding calculations in the 2025-2026 school year.

Recommendation

It is recommended the school board approve the request to submit a waiver to the Texas Education Agency for Duncanville ISD’s low attendance January 23 and January 29, 2026, due to inclement weather.
