Re: Out-of-State Varsity Baseball Team Trip Proposal



Geneva High School is requesting permission for the Varsity Baseball team to participate in an out-of-state field trip on the following dates: Friday, March 24, 2017 to Sunday, March 26, 2017 in Jacksonville, Illinois to compete in a downstate baseball tournament. The purpose of this trip is to allow the baseball team to compete with other baseball teams in the state. The tentative itinerary (attached) and trip details are as follows:

1. Trip Dates: Depart → Friday, March 24, 2017
Return → Sunday, March 26, 2017
2. Number of Student/Athletes Attending: Approximately 27
3. Transportation: Two Activity buses
4. Cost of Trip: Athletes (incidentals)/Fundraising to cover trip costs.
5. Rationale:
 - a. To provide the student athletes with an education, motivational and team-building experience that will have both individual and group benefits.
 - b. To allow an opportunity for the athletes to compete with out-of-state teams.

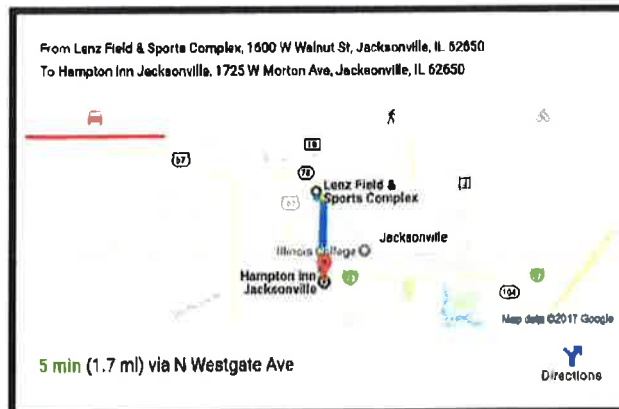

Cost of the Trip (per player): \$200

- ◆ **EXPENSES: Tournament costs (5 games), 2 nights in hotel w/ continental breakfast, 2 dinners and one lunch, transportation.**
- ◆ **FUNDRAISER: Each player will be expected to raise funds to help pay for the spring trip. The more the athlete raises, the less the trip will cost.**
 - 10-25 sold pays for uniform fee (\$100)
 - 30 sold \$50 will be deducted from the cost of the trip
 - 40 sold \$125 will be deducted from the cost of the trip
 - 50 sold \$200 will be deducted from the cost of the trip
- ◆ **Money due by Thursday, March 16th**

What to Bring:

- ◆ Both Hats
- ◆ Home uniform(Pins)
- ◆ Away uniform (Grays)
- ◆ Alternate jersey (Black)
- ◆ Warm clothing (weather too unpredictable)
- ◆ Baseball equipment, no cleats
- ◆ Clothes for during the day (Geneva cloth if you got it).

- ◆ Money for lunches other possible expenses*

*Dinner each day and lunch on the way home will be covered. Any additional costs (souvenirs, lunches, snacks, etc) will need to be covered by the players through their own money.
