

Consider approval of certification of provision of instructional materials

1. Board Goal:

2. Background:

In accordance with Texas Education Code (TEC), §31.1011 local educational agencies (LEAs) are required to certify annually to the State Board of Education (SBOE) and the commissioner that students have access to instructional materials covering all Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills (TEKS) for all required subjects, except physical education.

3. Process:

UCISD's Instructional Materials [adoption process](#) includes only those materials that meet the requirements for TEKS certification. All subject areas and all grade levels meet the TEKS standards. Upon board approval, we will submit to TEA, which will then allow us to be eligible to order 25-26 instructional materials through EMAT upon its opening in May for those requests.

4. Fiscal Impact:

Instructional materials ordered through the EMAT system are paid for with our Instructional Materials and Technology Allotment.
