A summer like no other...again



Purpose was to provide continued instructional learning for students with Individualized Education Plans (IEPs) as recommended through PPTs in accordance with state laws.

- Most of our programs (K-12) were offered remotely this summer to our IEP students through a synchronous format.
 - A small group of students received in-person programming or a combination of in-person and remote instruction
 - Pre-K/Kindergarten
 - Students receiving multiple services
 - High school credit recovery
 - Social Skills Camp





Social Skills Camp/Support

- Conducted in-person for two weeks
- Targeted Goals and Objectives related to social skill development for students
- Total participants: 12 students

Camp Kelly

- 5 weeks of in-person instruction
- Preschool students
- OT, PT, and Speech provided during the hours of the program
- Total participants: 9 students

Get Ready for Kinder

- 4 weeks of in-person instruction (2 hours per day)
- Entering kindergarten students
- OT, PT, Speech provided during the program hours
- Total participants: 8 students



Tutoring

- Individualized in-person or remote instruction based a student's goals and objectives in the IEP
- Total participants: 22 students

Credit Recovery

- Conducted in-person and remote for 4 weeks
- To complete or regain credit toward graduation requirements
- Total participants: 14 students

Academic Classes

- 4 weeks of in-person or remote instruction targeting core academic skills from the previous year and previewing early skills from the upcoming grade level
- Total participants: 184 students

Enrollment Across All Services

- High School (Credit Recovery): 14 students
- High School (per IEP): 12 students
- GMMS: 52 students
- Wells Road: 81 students
- Kelly Lane: 62 students
