RESOLUTION OF THE WHARTON COUNTY JUNIOR COLLEGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES

WHEREAS, Wharton County Junior College ("WCJC" or the "College") has conducted a nationwide search to fill a vacancy in the WCJC Chief Information Officer position;

WHEREAS, as a result of the search, the College President has identified Mr. Scott S. Towsley as the most qualified candidate to fill that position and has recommended Mr. Towsley's employment to the Board of Trustees for approval;

WHEREAS, the Board believes a compelling public interest exists in ensuring that the College employs the most qualified candidate in the position of Chief Information Officer;

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees believes that there is a benefit to the College in reimbursing qualified candidates for costs incurred in relocation to Wharton, Texas so that the candidate can serve in the position of WCJC Chief Information Officer;

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees finds that a public purpose and a benefit to WCJC exists in approving the reimbursement of expenses incurred by Mr. Towsley in connection with his relocation to live in Wharton, Texas so that he can serve in the position of WCJC Chief Information Officer, in an amount not to exceed \$5,000.00;

FURTHER, the Board of Trustees finds that any funds paid to Mr. Towsley as reimbursement for relocation expenses must be refunded to WCJC if Mr. Towsley voluntarily terminates his employment with WCJC prior to the completion of one calendar year of service.
