- commitment to the governance structures that guide both LISD schools and local PTAs.

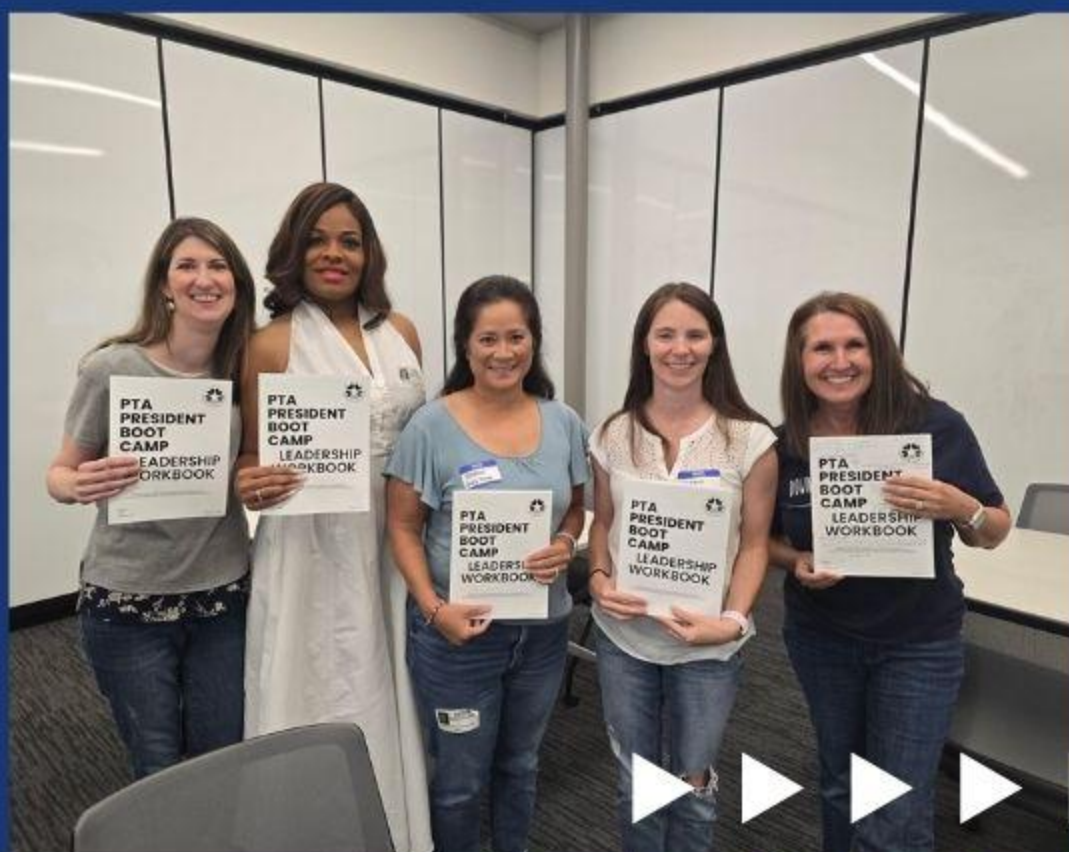
