Formative Assessment with Socrative 5 hours - 1/2 Board Credit 20 seats - available to all teachers grades K - 12 January 15, 22, 29, February 5, 12

Formative assessment has been identified by Dr. Robert Marzano as a key strategy for creating an environment where students can be successful. With effective formative assessment, teachers are better able to determine what students truly know and how they growing academically while in the progress of learning. A truly effective tool to create, administer, and analyze common formative assessments is Socrative. This free tool allows educators the chance to collectively create their short quizzes where all teachers are able to give the same assessment. By doing so, staff are able to look at common questions, and share what teaching strategies worked and what may not have worked.

For this course, we will also be employing a blended learning model. In this format, teachers will only meet face-to-face for the initial and final learning session. The remaining weeks will be conducted online including a product to be submitted each week and a discussion topic to post their thoughts and ideas.
