AGENDA ITEM: Consideration of Approval for the District President to Exercise a Contract Option with AECOM Technical Services, Inc. to Provide Program Management Support for the Balance of the Projects in Phases 3 and 4 of the 2017 Bond Program

DISCUSSION: On April 25, 2017, the Board of Trustees authorized the District President to negotiate a contract with AECOM Technical Services, Inc. to be considered for approval by the Board of Trustees in the May 6, 2017 bond election.

The contract segmented program management services were to be performed by AECOM in 4 phases. The projects contained in Phases 1 and 2 are currently under construction, and three (3) of the Phase 3 projects are currently in the design/pre-construction phase. The balance of Phase 3 and all of Phase 4 are available to the College by exercising written contract extensions.

This proposal is to move forward with the extension of the contract with AECOM for program management services for the balance of the Phase 3 and 4 projects, which includes major additions and renovations at the Frisco Campus and McKinney Campus, Trane PACT energy upgrades at all existing campuses as well as wayfinding / signage work at the Plano Campus, Frisco Campus, and McKinney Campus.

The contract request for these services is not to exceed \$1,052,000.

DISTRICT PRESIDENT'S RECOMMENDATION: The District President recommends the Board of Trustees authorizes the District President to execute a contract with AECOM Technical Services, Inc. for Bond Program Management Services for Phases 3 and 4 of the 2017 Bond Program, as outlined above.

SUGGESTED MOTION: "Mr. Chairman, I make a motion that the Board of Trustees of Collin County Community College District authorize the District President to execute a contract extension with AECOM Technical Services, Inc. for Bond Program Management Services related to additions and renovations at the Frisco Campus and McKinney

Campus, Trane PACT energy upgrades at all existing campuses, and wayfinding / signage work at the Plano Campus, Frisco Campus, and McKinney Campus in Phases 3 and 4 of the 2017 Bond Program at a fee not to exceed \$1,052,000.”
