How are we doing?

We have been tracking the new students In and the outgoing students. In the month of September there were 74 new students that transferred in. There were 87 that transferred out . Out of those 74 in- 7 of the new students have already transferred out to another district/town. This has all been within the first month of school.

Student Highlights:

The first Super Kids parties were held the week of September 30-October 4, 2013. There were many students that had never had the opportunity to participate, but have had great behavior this year.

Open House/Ice Cream Social was a huge success. We served 13 5 gallon tubs of ice cream. That is the most that we have ever done! It was great to see all the FCS families.

What's New:

Everyone at FCS has been practicing Common Area Lesson Plans. The PBIS team created those last year. All staff at FCS have taken their classes to the areas and practiced what the expectations are for each area. Some of these areas are: hallways, cafeteria, playground, front office, etc. There are beautiful new signs that remind all students what the expectations are. This has been very helpful with reducing discipline referrals.
