The following are donations under \$1000

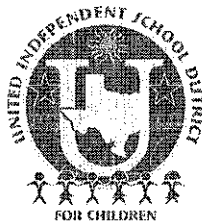

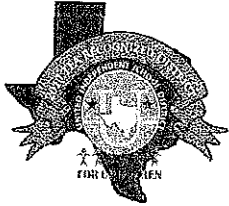
