Kindergarten

Our students have gotten back into the swing of things here in Kindergarten! In ELAR for the month of February, we will explore books by sharing opinions, making text connections, and reviewing story elements, main idea, and sensory details. Our students will write complete sentences and use writing conventions in our writing. We will continue working very hard on our Sight Words. Lastly in ELAR for this month, we will be beginning to learn poetry. For Math, our Kinder students will take their knowledge of composing and decomposing numbers and apply this toward solving addition problems. February is going to be a big month for Social Studies, where we will study historical figures for Black History Month, as well as celebrate Presidents Day by studying those presidents current and past.

First Grade

In reading, we will be reading many different fables, fairy tales, and poems in first grade. Students will be able to use rhythm, rhyme, and alliteration in poetry. We will also start reviewing all fiction story elements. In language arts, students will be able to understand and use verbs as well as contractions and adjectives. In math students should be able to identify coins including pennies, nickels, dimes, and quarters by value and describe the relationships among them. They should also be able to use the cent symbol to describe the set of coins, as well as be able to count a collection of coins. In social studies, we are comparing the past and present. In science, we are studying different living things.
