



Director of Curriculum & Instruction's Board Report
April 2, 2026

1. Teacher Incentive Allotment (TIA)

Designation confirmations should be in SCOMS after April 22. We will notify newly designated teachers after that date. The end-of-year testing window for TIA is April 27 through May 8. Application submission is April 15 and data collection for the 2025-26 school year is continuing.

2. LIFT Grant

Danielle Neely from Region 5 will act as our LIFT District coach. Together, we will conduct a needs assessment in order to create an action plan moving forward. Our initial meeting with Danielle will be on April 15. We are looking forward to working with them on this implementation.

3. Secondary Math Curriculum

On April 10, secondary math teachers will visit Liberty ISD for an informational session to learn more about Bluebonnet Learning. Teachers have been provided with a rubric to evaluate Bluebonnet, SAVVAS, and McGraw Hill curricula. Over the next several weeks, we will meet to review and analyze each option. Upon completion of this process, a final recommendation will be presented to the board for consideration.

4. Child Care Center - Updated Enrollment

The Child Care Center currently serves **18 children**: four infants (with one more enrolling soon), four full-time toddlers, and ten preschoolers, eight of whom attend the Pre-K3 half-day program.

5. State Assessments
