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

Straight Line Routes For Williams Elementary School

In the event of adverse weather conditions parents are advised to tune in to Radio Stations KRWQ, KAJQ, KLDL, KBOY and TV Stations KOB1 (5), KDRV (12), KTVL (10) or the Three Rivers School District Web Page (www.threerivers.k12.or.us) for information on school bus schedules, delays or closures.

Sometimes weather conditions leave some roads blocked or unsafe to travel but school is still being held. Under these circumstances "straight line routes" will be run. This is the information you will get on the web page or radio/TV stations.

When straight line routes are run the roads affected are listed below. If you live on one of the roads the buses cannot travel, you may bring your student to the nearest intersection of the main road. This will also be the stop for the afternoon drop off.

December Holiday Parent Luncheon-Thursday, December 15th

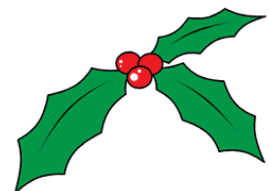
