Wood Dale School District 7 Summer Math Program Summary 2017

Session: June 20, 2017-August 3, 2017 (12:00-2:00 on Tuesday's & Thursday's)

Enrollment: 2017: 27 students (2 withdrawn students- Move out's)

Staffing: Two teachers, Mrs. Garbacz and Mrs. Willson each worked the session and Mr. DiPalermo and Mrs. Subach subbed.

Cost: Free except for the cost of bussing (\$25.00). 17 students were placed on bus routes. This included 63% of the students. The availability of the bus helped regulate attendance and for many parents was the only transportation available to get to and from class.

Principal's Report: The summer math program was for students performing between the 20th and 40th percentiles on their previous Math MAP test that did not qualify for summer school. This group was given intensive math instruction that included Khan Academy, math games and targeted instruction based on their individual skill deficits. Students were issued chromebooks to be able to use in class and at home for the duration of the program. There was an expectation that each student was to complete assigned practice that was individually tailored to their skill sets. This occurred during the face to face class time and as homework assigned weekly. The teachers reported that students were enthusiastic and worked hard throughout the summer to improve their math skills. We will be monitoring the effectiveness of the program by analyzing future MAP data.
