REQUEST FOR APPROVAL OF APPOINTMENT / REAPPOINTMENT OF SCHOOL HEALTH ADVISORY COUNCIL (SHAC) MEMBERS

A Board shall establish a local School Health Advisory Council (SHAC) to assist a District in ensuring that local community values are reflected in the District's health education instruction. A majority of the council must be parents of students enrolled in the District and who are not employed by the District. The Board may also appoint one (1) or more school teachers, public school administrators, district students, healthcare professionals, members of the business community, law enforcement representatives, senior citizens, clergy, representatives of non-profit health organizations, or representatives from other groups.
