To enhance the MCHS Cheerleading Program, we propose the addition of a third level, which would provide more student-athletes with the opportunity to participate, develop essential cheerleading skills, and grow in a supportive environment. This new level would serve as a foundation for athletes who may not yet possess the skills required for the Junior Varsity or Varsity teams, fostering skill development, teamwork, and sportsmanship. Furthermore, it would contribute to the continued promotion of school spirit. Each year, an increasing number of student-athletes are unable to make the team due to limited spots, and we believe that the introduction of a third level will not only accommodate these athletes but also encourage greater student participation in tryouts.

Description: The Freshman Cheerleading team would compete as a fall sport and follow the IHSA terms and conditions.
