



# Chamberlin Campus Improvement Plan Summary

**2022-23**

The campus theme for the 22-23 year is **“Our Time to Shine”** - classroom and campus decor is centered around the FARM where hard work leads to a bountiful harvest.

Our plan largely focuses on continued, quality implementation of recent curriculum changes and participation in the Raising Blended Learners Grant. A few changes worth noting include:

- Increased support for student behavior/social and emotional learning
  - Addition of General Education Behavior Teacher
  - Increase Behavior Aide (serving both general ed and special ed) to full time
- Science of Teaching Reading - increased focus on phonics instruction with continued critical attention to text features and comprehension while fostering the love of reading and learning.
- Elimination of 2 instructional aide positions
- Safety Spotlights in staff meetings and in weekly newsletters when necessary.
- Name Changes
  - From Rtl (Response to Intervention) to MTSS (Multi-Tiered Systems of Support)
  - From Gomez y Gomez to Flexible Bilingualism
- Utilize communication tools that enable translation by the user.
