The new copiers were installed on March 15th and 19th. So far things are going smoothly with the transition over to new equipment and software. Students in the Secondary are now able to print from their Chromebooks when needed. They receive an allocation of 20 pages per month. We will see how this goes and may need to adjust things in the future.

Skyler and I have been working on and off on the phones. It's nice to have time to get this all completed before the full transition on June 3rd. We needed to get phone numbers built for areas of the school to publish in the new community education brochure. We want to make this transition for parents and the community as smooth as possible. We are very excited about all the features we will now have for communications and also how much less money this will cost us each month.

Skyler has been working on building our new firewall. We have many more options than we currently have. One of the things we will be using is a feature called GeoFencing. We are able to block regions of the world so that they can not access our network. We are hoping this will keep possible cyber attacks down from known hotspots for that kind of activity. Our plan is to install this in June.

Testing started on April 9th. We have been working with Beth and Nicole to make sure all the Chromebooks are ready for MCA testing.
