AGENDA ITEM: Report Out of the Finance and Audit Committee and Consideration of Approval of the Comprehensive Annual Financial Report (CAFR) and Related Report from Independent Auditor Grant Thornton LLP for the 2018-2019 Fiscal Year

DISCUSSION: Abernathy, Roeder, Boyd & Hullett P.C. have been providing the collection of delinquent taxes since the inception of the District. This arrangement was made through the tax collection contract that Collin College has with Collin County. The College and our attorneys both think it is prudent to have our own separate contract.

Payment for these services is through the collection of fees collected from the taxpayer as provided by Texas Property Tax Code Section 33. A delinquent tax roll will be furnished to Abernathy, Roeder, Boyd & Hullett P.C. for the purposes of collecting taxes on behalf of the District.

Texas Education Code 44.031 (f) exempts the procurement of services performed by attorneys from the competitive solicitation process.

DISTRICT PRESIDENT'S RECOMMENDATION: The District President recommends approval to engage Abernathy, Roeder, Boyd & Hullett P.C. to Serve the District in the collection of all delinquent ad valorem taxes, penalty and interest owed to the District.
