



Current FSPS Components Of School Safety

Access Control

 Schools and district building have access controlled vestibules and/or access controlled camera/card system

Regular Building Safety Audits

- All exterior doors locked
- All interrior doors locked
- All staff wears appropriate identification
- Visitor check in procedures

Crisis and Reunification Plans

- District Crisis Plan
- School Site Crisis Plan
- District Response and Reunification Plan (Counseling, Support, Logistics, & Communications)



Weapons Detection Research

 Research is being conducted on how weapons detection systems might enhance the FSPS Comprehensive School Safety Assessments.

Surveillance Camera System

• There are approximately 1500 cameras in the district.


Police Presence and Response

- Fort Smith Public Schools Police Department has a presence on each secondary campus
- Fort Smith Public Schools Police Department has four patrol officers that are each assigned to 4 to 5 elementary schools, Belle Point, Peak and Adult Education
- Fort Smith Public Schools Police Department operates a dispatch center
- Fort Smith Public Schools Police Department employees a social worker with expertise in Behavior Threat Assessment
- 14 full-time officers (Chief, Lt., 4 High School, 4 Middle School, 4 Elementary), 3 part-time officers, 1 Dispatcher, 1 Social Worker & 1 Volunteer Police Officer

Safety and Security Audits

Classroom Doors Locked

All classroom doors are locked when students are present.




Exterior Doors

All exterior doors are locked when students are present.

Visitor Protocols

The defined process for visitor access to district facilities will be followed.




ID Badges

All school employees should be wearing identification badges at all times when on a district campus.

Safety and Security Drills Conducted

All safety and security drills are conducted according to prescribed timelines.



Safety and Security Data

Safety and Security Staff will conduct weekly audits, gather data, present data to the administration and prescribe corrective actions.

Al Systems

- -Evolv = \$120K over 3 years.
- -Xtract One = \$72K over 3 years

Systems <u>Approximate</u> Cost



Metal Detector Systems

- -CEIA opengate = \$20-30K
- -Garret = \$7K
- -The bundle includes Paragon metal detectors, caster systems, 14-hour lithium-ion battery packs, Super Scanner V handheld scanners, assemble, setup, training, and freight.
- Garrett is made in the USA, and is a member of TIPS cooperative contract. They provide a 3-year warranty and are willing to troubleshoot remotely as needed.



Weapon Detection Cameras

- -Omni Alert and Zero Eyes
- -Includes: Camera license fees for (264) cameras, third party monitoring, & Omnilert servers to support at 27 campuses.
- This would be the approximate annual renewal fee.
- Additional servers will be needed to support this system.



Systems <u>Approximate</u> Cost



MSA Security - Firearms Detection Canine & Handler

Total Annual Price = \$197,600

- -This gives us a dog and handler 365 days a year. They provide substitutes for dog & handler if they have to go to the vet, attend training, or are not able to support FSPS for some reason.
- If possible the handler might be able to conduct security assessments for FSPS police force in summer when school is not in session.




District Owned - Weapons and Drug Detection Canine


Total Annual Price = \$15,000 to \$20,000


-The district would purchase a dog and use one of the current officers to be the handler.



Logistics - Short Range & Long Range Plan (NHS)









<u>Approximate</u> Staffing

Staffing Requirements:

A total of **12 security staff** members will be required to operate and monitor the metal detectors or weapon detection systems at both NHS and SHS. A total of **8 security staff** members will be required to operate and monitor the metal detectors at the 4 middle schools. A total of **4 security staff** would be required to operate and monitor the metal detectors at Peak and Belle Point. The staffing requirements are as follows:

A. Northside High School:

Entry Point 1: 2 Security Staff Members Entry Point 2: 2 Security Staff Members Entry Point 3: 2 Security Staff Members 6 Total Staff Members for NHS

B. Southside High School:

Entry Point 1: 2 Security Staff Members Entry Point 2: 2 Security Staff Members Entry Point 3: 2 Security Staff Members 6 Total Staff Members for SHS

C. Peak

Entry Point 1: 2 Security Staff Members 2 Total Staff Members for Peak

D. Middle Schools:

Entry Point 1: 2 Security Staff Members (per school) 8 Total for all 4 middle schools

E. Belle Point

Entry Point 1: 2 Security Staff Members 2 Total Staff Members for Belle Point



Staffing

Staff Responsibilities:

The security staff will be responsible for the following tasks at each entry point:

- 1. Operate and monitor the metal detectors or weapon detection system.
- 2. Conduct thorough security checks, ensuring that no unauthorized weapons or dangerous items are brought into the school.
- 3. Interact with students, staff, and visitors in a professional and respectful manner.
- 4. Notify school administrators or law enforcement if a potential threat is detected.
- 5. Maintain records and reports regarding daily activities and incidents.
