# Connecticut Next Generation Accountability System for Districts and Schools

- Provides a more complete picture of a school or district
- Encourages leaders to view accountability results not as a “gotcha” but as a tool to guide and track improvement efforts
- Developed by CT Department of Education with extensive feedback from district and school leaders, Connecticut educators, state and national experts, CSDE staff, and many others

1. Academic achievement (Performance Index)
2. Academic growth
3. Assessment participation rate
4. Chronic absenteeism
5. Preparation for postsecondary and career readiness – coursework
6. Preparation for postsecondary and career readiness – exams
7. Graduation – on track in ninth grade
8. Graduation – four-year adjusted cohort
9. Graduation – six-year adjusted cohort
10. Postsecondary Entrance Rate
11. Physical fitness
12. Arts access

# Achievement Rate Gaps/ Participation rate

A district/school is identified as having an “achievement gap” if its gap size is substantially different (greater) from the average statewide gap in any subject area.

We are required to have a participation rate above 95% in all areas.

# School Classification

There are five categories per state law based on accountability index:

- Category 1: top quartile
- Category 2: two middle quartiles
- Category 3: bottom quartile
- Categories 4 & 5: existing turn around/focus schools

\* Any Category 1 and 2 schools are lowered a category if participation rate falls below 95% OR if there is an achievement gap in ELA, Math or Science

# Woodbridge School District

- Data review to determine implications for instructional change in Physical Education
- Continued monitoring and communication to address absenteeism
- Examine systems and structures that support High Needs Students and students receiving intervention (Strategic Plan)
- Continue Strategic Plan Initiatives that support all students
