Goal/Objective Addressed	Student Achievement Crosby ISD will ensure that every student achieves their full academic potential by providing high quality instruction, engaging learning opportunities, and a supportive environment that prepares all learner for success in an ever-changing world.
Background	Chapter 37 of the Texas Education Code requires that HCJB establish and operate a Juvenile Justice Alternative Education Program (JJAEP) for youth who are expelled from school for the offenses described in Section 37.007 (a), (d), and (e) of the Texas Education Code. Chapter 54 of the Texas Family Code provides that the juvenile court, at a child's disposition hearing, may order the child to attend the JJAEP. School districts may contract with HCJB for placement of students in the JJAEP who are expelled from school for the offenses described in Section 37.007 (b), (c), and (f), Section 37.0081, Section 37.302, or who are ordered to attend the JJAEP by a juvenile court, as described in Section 54.04(b) of the Texas Family Code.
