



APPROVAL OF SUSIE A. LAUGHLIN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP FUND TRUSTEES

POLICY ISSUE / SITUATION:

To comply with Beaverton School District policy (JI), the School Board must appoint trustees of the Claude R. Laughlin Trust, aka the Susie A. Laughlin Memorial Scholarship Fund.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Beaverton School District policy (JI) requires that the School Board “shall appoint two trustees to serve terms of three years each who shall be either Board members or administrators in the District. Each trustee shall have the right to resign at any time. Trustees appointed by the Board may be removed by the Board any time upon ten days’ notice in writing to the said trustee. When a trusteeship is vacated, the Board shall appoint a successor trustee. The executive administrator for business services shall serve in an advisory role to the trustees”.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the School Board approve the following resolution:

BE IT RESOLVED that the School Board of Beaverton School District appoint Deputy Superintendent Carl Mead and Deputy Superintendent Steve Phillips as the new trustees for the Susie A. Laughlin Memorial Scholarship Fund.
