### I. SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

- A. Preliminary Enrollment Figures: Supt. Glaes reported that the 2014-15 budget was based on flat enrollment. Enrollment numbers are close to projection, and Supt. Glaes will keep the Board informed as count day gets closer.
- B. Report on Opening Preservice Activities and Ceremonies John O'Toole: Mr. O'Toole described the school improvement process to the Board and how the Opening Preservice Activities fall under the SIP umbrella. The District vision is "All students will graduate college and career ready." The mission is "to maximize the success and potential of each student." Mr. O'Toole recognized the department chairs for their teacher leadership.
- C. Status of Open Positions: Supt. Glaes reviewed the status of positions to date.
- D. Reproductive Health Program Parent Notification for 2014-15: Supt. Glaes stated that there were no curriculum changes to the program. The annual notification will be mailed the end of September to all households.
- E. Legislative Update: Supt. Glaes referred to the School Equity Caucus which talked about issues coming out of the lame duck session.

- 1. Budget Progress Report: Asst. Supt. Goss reviewed the budget progress report for August, 2014 showing total revenues of \$205,202; total expenditures of \$1,318,260; and deficiency of revenues over expenditures of -\$1,173,058.
- B. Focus School Quarterly Report Pat Moreno and Jamie Masco: Pat Moreno recognized Jamie Masco for her leadership with Focus School initiatives. Since Sunset Lake Elementary is no longer on the State's Focus School list, Ms. Masco gave the final required quarterly report, which included Sunset Lake's summer school results.

- C. Athletic Department Annual Report Michael Roy, Athletic Director: Mr. Roy expressed his appreciation to Athletic Secretary Ronda VanderKamp and the Athletic Boosters. Mr. Roy reviewed the list of tournaments hosted, the number of sports that were academic all state, participation numbers, student scholarships, and special honors.
