RECOMMENDATIONS

Kennedy Zapata Elementary sustained substantial water damage due to a domestic water line part failure inside one of the workrooms. The part failure allowed water to flow over the course of 2 days (the weekend) inside the building causing classrooms, office areas, halls and the library to collect approximately 1-2 inches of water. Upon arrival on Monday morning March 4th, the head custodian immediately noticed the water collected inside the building and was able to close the water valve. At this point, it was decided that classes needed to be canceled until an assessment of how extensive the damage could be conducted. The District mobilized a team of people from various departments to assess and to begin the cleanup process. Because additional time was needed to dry the floors and continue cleaning, it was decided to cancel classes on Tuesday as well so that District and campus staff could best prepare to receive the students on Wednesday, March 6, 2019.
