Get rid of secondary only early release, hard to get kids home who can't get a ride and parents are at work (staff kids mainly) and causes early sign outs at lower campuses, option b would be my vote (I like the starting earlier and ending earlier and less early release days)
Handrick/Simmons	Starting earlier gets us done before the Memorial Day weekend which seems to impact attendance the last week of school. So Option B works best. We would add the early release back on the Friday before spring break if possible. Option B gives 4 day weekends for the students in September along with the other months that are the same with 4 day weekends. Having an earlier end date would allow seniors to schedule college fish camps earlier. Earlier end date gives the high school more time prior to summer school starting to reach parents and students about the need for summer school attendance.
