### **E-Learning Plan Renewal 2025 – 2028 – ACTION**

#### **The Issue:**

Board of Education approval is required for the renewal of the district's E Learning Plan. Renewal is required every three years.

#### **Justification:**

Illinois Public Act 101-0012 requires that the Board of Education approve the district's E-Learning Plan.

#### **Board Policy and Past Practices:**

Policy 6:20: The Board of Education, upon the Superintendent's recommendation, annually establishes the school calendar. The use of E-Learning Days would replace the emergency days, which are included in that calendar.

#### **Strategic Plan Goal(s):**

- Graduation Goal: 100% of students have a pathway to be enlisted, employed, or enrolled in a post-graduation program at the time of graduation.
- ELA Goal: 100% of students can actively interact with and comprehend grade-level text, and/or at least 75% of students demonstrate mastery on Common Formative Assessments (CFAs).
- Math Goal: 100% of students can perform at grade-level expectations and/or at least 75% of students demonstrate mastery on Common Formative Assessments (CFAs).

#### **Community Impact:**

The community expects the adoption of an E-Learning Plan to support and avoid interruptions in instruction occurring when school cannot be held due to the following:

- severe weather conditions
- "an act of God"
- conditions outside the control of the school district that could pose a hazardous threat to the health and safety of pupils
