RE: Standards for Accreditation –Class Size Exceptions

Dr. Sutherlin,

The Foreman School District is seeking a waiver under Ark. Code Ann. 6-15-202(b)(2)(A) for the remainder of this school year. We had an elementary teacher resign before Christmas break, at that time, the class size was not over the max of 25 students. We moved the students from her class to the other second grade teacher, along with an aide. On February 22, 2022 a student enrolled and caused an exception of class size overage. The District plans to hire a second grade teacher at our Board meeting on Monday, March 7, 2022 for the 2022/2023 school year.

The following classes are showing to have twenty-six (26) students enrolled in classrooms that are set for a maximum number of twenty-five (25) students each. Each of the following classes are showing to have the overage of one student for all of the four (4) marking periods during the current school year:

- Course #222520; Section 2225202—Music 2nd Grade, Shelby Tuskey—26 students, Marking Periods 1, 2, 3, & 4.
- Course #222510; Section 2225102—Visual Arts 2nd Grade, Deirdre—26 students, Marking Periods 1, 2, 3, & 4.
- Course #222310; Section 2223102—Math 2nd Grade, Michelle Green—26 students, Marking Periods 1, 2, 3, & 4.
- Course #222610; Section 2226102—Science & Health 2nd Grade, Michelle Green—26 students, Marking Periods 1, 2, 3, & 4.
- Course #222710; Section 2227102—Social Studies 2nd Grade, Michelle Green—26 students, Marking Periods 1, 2, 3, & 4.
