BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

In collaboration with district administration, board member representatives developed a budget parameters memorandum for final board review and approval.

The purpose of this memorandum is to develop parameters that enable the district to provide a financially solvent budget that meets all short-term and long-term obligations and is aligned to the vision, mission, and goals alignment with the G-PISD balanced scorecard.
