Background	House Bill 3033 ("HB3033") passed during the 88th Legislative Session
	added Section 552.0031 to the Texas Government Code and defined
	"business day" under the Texas Public Information Act to mean a day other than:
	1. A Saturday or Sunday;
	A national holiday under Texas Government Code Section
	662.003(a); or
	3. A state holiday under Texas Government Code Section
	662.003(b).
	4. HB 3033 provides that the Board of Trustees of a school district
	may designate up to ten (10) days in each calendar year as
	nonbusiness days, on which the governmental entity's
	administrative offices are closed or operating with minimum
	staffing but are not national or state holidays.
