## Re: Prospering Pals Purchasing Cooperative Interlocal Agreement Resolution

- A. This agreement allows the Director of Child Nutrition and our Child Nutrition Department to partner and combine the district purchasing power with other school districts through a Purchasing Cooperative Interlocal Agreement. An Interlocal Agreement is one of the accepted competitive procurement options under the Texas Education Code Chapter 44.031 (a); (b) and is an allowable procurement method according to the Texas Department of Agriculture Administrative Reference Manual section 17c.
- B. Membership is open to all school districts in the Dallas Fort Worth Metroplex, but we will only add members at the time of bid issuance.
- C. This agreement will allow the member of the Prospering Pals Cooperative to streamline the bidding process. As a result, the cooperative will benefit all of the participating school districts.
- D. There is no fee for participating in this cooperative. Any costs associated with the issuance of the RFP are shared evenly among the member districts.
- E. The combined purchasing power will benefit the taxpayers of Coppell ISD due to the potential cost savings through economy of scale.

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

That the Coppell ISD Board of Trustees approve the Interlocal Agreement for current and future districts to participate in the Prospering Pals Cooperative.
