Climate Goal

2009-10 Goals

- Increase the % of students who have at least one adult they could talk to from 83% to 90%.
- Increase the number of students who completed the student survey from 485 to 900 with 45% being male.
- Increase the number of students who have not been bullied from 65% to 75%.
- Increase the number of students who often or always feel safe at BHS from 95% to 100%
- Increase the number of staff who report they know people outside of their department from 76% to 81%

2009-10 Results

- 85% reported they had at least one adult they could talk to if they had a problem.
- 1331 students took the survey 48.8% were male
- 71% reported they have not been bullied
- 96% reported they feel safe at BHS
- 72.7% of staff reported they knew someone outside their department

2009-10 Goals

- All students successfully complete graduation requirement in reading
- Demonstrate a 5.2% increase in the overall percentage of students meeting proficiency standards on the MCA-II's in reading.
- Demonstrate 2.5% increase in overall percentage of students meeting MAP growth target (5% growth over 2 years).
- Top 40 in Reading Ranking by MCA-II/GRAD scores

2009-10 Results

- All seniors successfully completed their graduation requirements in reading.
- 82.6% of 10th graders were proficient on this Springs MCA-II assessment
 - Goal was 84.6%
- 57% of 9th graders met their growth target on their spring MAP reading assessment
 - Goal was 62.1%
- Top 40 in Reading 46th

Math Goal

2009-10 Goals

- Demonstrate a 6.5% increase in the overall percentage of students meeting proficiency standards on the MCA-IIs in math.
- Demonstrate 2.5% increase in overall percentage of students meeting MAP growth targets (5% growth over 2 years).
- Top 40 in Math Ranking by MCA-II/GRAD scores

2009-10 Results

- 47.2% of 11th graders were proficient on the MCA-II Math Assessment
 - Goal 46.8%
- 68.3% of 9th graders met MAP growth target in Math this year
 - Goal 67.4%
- Top 40 in Math 41st
