

Napi Mini Bank

- 1. Club Goals for the Year: The Napi Mini Bank goals for the year are to increase the number of students with savings accounts by 50 students. In addition to the 50 savings accounts, the secondary goal is for 100 deposits to be made in the new accounts or an average of two deposits per new account (in addition to the initial deposit that opens the account). The long term goals of the Blackfeet Mini Bank Association are to encourage students to develop savings habits. The desired outcome is for students to accumulate a substantial amount for college, start a business, or a major purchase such as an automobile or down payment on a home by the time they graduate high school.
- Regular Meetings: The Napi Mini Bank will meet once a week, from 11:00AM to 12:30PM every other Wednesday. Board members will alternate weeks worked to minimize classroom interruptions.
- Club Activities: During the course of the year, at least 2 drawings will be held for those students who have deposited money in their accounts. Board members will help organize fundraisers to buy prizes for these drawings.
- 4. Board Members: Duties of the board members are to act as tellers, customer service representatives, new account recruiters etc. during Mini Bank hours. As well as participate in planning meetings and all other activities. Board members are selected by teacher recommendation. The board members for 2016-2017 will be announced at the end of November 2016. Ray Croff will act as Napi Mini Bank Sponsor.
