early release day for their final exams week in December and May, this reduces their calendar instructional minutes by 270 minutes. By adding the proposed professional development waiver minutes, which total 1170 instructional minutes, we will meet, and exceed, the requirement of 75,600 instructional minutes for all campuses. The total instructional minutes for the Elementary and Intermediate campuses with the added professional development waiver minutes will be 76,800 and the total instructional minutes for the Junior High and High School campuses will be 76,530. The addition of professional development waiver minutes provides the district with some flexibility should we have a severe weather event or other potential incident that would cause an unforeseen school closure, which would ultimately reduce our total instructional minutes.

Background Information:

The Texas Education Agency (TEA) allows for districts to request a staff development minutes waiver that provides for a maximum of 2,100 total waiver minutes to use for professional development. This waiver is for staff development in place of student instruction; therefore, the waiver minutes are only applicable to staff development provided instead of student instruction during the school year. The *Staff Development Minutes Waiver* may not be used prior to the first day of student instruction or after the last day of student instruction.
