Organizations Currently underway at Wylie High School.

1. Med Life- The MEDLIFE chapter at Wylie High School was started by a team of four very energetic high schoolers interested in both local and international medical and community outreach to impoverished communities around the world. Junior Ava DePrang is the president of the group and was the one who first contacted the international organization as to the possibility of Wylie High School starting a chapter. Most chapters are college chapters, and Wylie is one of very few high school chapters in the country. The Wylie group allows for all interested students to become a part of the service projects and if available, to attend a Service Learning Trip in Lima, Peru, during the summer. During the 2018-2019 school year, fifteen students from the Wylie chapter served at the Abilene Food Bank for its first local outreach, and five students from the chapter attended, along with two chaperones, the Service Learning Trip in Lima this past July. Although the trip to Peru involves a substantial cost, the group will be involved in fundraising opportunities to help defray those costs. The group meets monthly at the high school and there are no required dues to be a member. Students interested in service to needy communities can be pursuing any career field, not just medicine.
